U.I.M. rules for River Marathon Racing will apply as well as the following:

**In order to race, each boat must be equipped with all the items on the attached checklist.**

**Boat drivers, navigators and driver of chase vehicle** must have a valid CBF membership; these will be available for purchase at registration.

All racers must have their Pleasure Craft Operators' License.

All race drivers require CBF medicals

All boats must start in the 70 m staging area

All new racers must have an orientation course & driving test and should start in the FX class.

All racers will be required to complete a medical questionnaire as requested by CBF

Motors of the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> place boats in each class will be subject to a tech inspection immediately after the last leg of the race, **please proceed to Nitehawk Ski Hill immediately after completion of last leg for inspection.**

**Any racers in LSX, CX or FX caught cheating with engines** will have their motor confiscated & sold with proceeds to charity; this racer will be banned from the next 3 races

No Oxidized Fuel allowed in LSX, CX, or FX

Race fuel will **NOT** be provided.

## Race Class Rules 2014

### The Canadian Boating Federation – Western Zone/ Jet River

#### Unlimited Jet Class – 300 Series Recommended Numbers (U300)

- Hull any shape or material with a minimum length of 16 feet (4.88m)
- Unlimited engine restrictions or modifications, any exhaust c/w mufflers
- Jet Engines do not require mufflers
- Propulsion – jet drive
- Roll bar (well mounted & braced) chrome moly recommended

#### “A+” Jet Class – 200 Series Recommended Numbers (A200)

- Hull any shape or material with a minimum length of 16 feet (4.88m)
- Engine displacement shall not exceed 470 cubic inches (7700 cc)
- Superchargers, blowers & turbos are allowed at 1.8 x cubic inch ratio
- Oxygenated Fuel Allowed
- Exhaust - any exhaust c/w mufflers
- Propulsion – jet drive
- Roll bar (well mounted & braced) chrome moly recommended
- Or/AMS Spec Engine, 565 cu in, No Oxygenated Fuel
- Or/US BAFX Class (502 cu in)

#### “LSX” Jet Class – 200 series Recommended Numbers (LSX200)

- Hull any shape or material with a minimum length of 16 feet (4.88m)
- **Stock Crate Engine** shall be GM LSX 454 part #19244611(620 hp version)**No modifications**
- **No** overbore, no sleeves, no grinding, no cutting, no filing, no milling, no porting, no balancing or engine modifications, no valve seat modifications, untouched factory heads only.
- Modified cooling systems allowed, air/water bleed ports, can be enlarged or added, with or without water pump.
- Any oil Pan(no dry sumps or vacuum pumps allowed)any valve covers, any ignition or distributor
- Any intake or fuel injection allowed, intake modifications allowed, Any carburetor(s) No Oxygenated Fuel Allowed
- Repaired engines must use GM parts pertaining to that engine.
- Exhaust - Any exhaust system allowed c/w mufflers
- Propulsion - jet drive
- Roll bar (well mounted & braced) chrome moly recommended
- Or/Old B-Class 366 cu in Motors, Oxygenated Fuel Allowed

**“CX” Jet Class** – 100 or 200 Series Recommended Numbers (CX100 or CX200)

- Hull any shape or material with a minimum length of 16 feet (4.88m)
- **Stock Crate Engine** shall be GM LS3 Engines 376ci CT525
- GM #19259233/525 Fuel Inj., GM #19271821/525 Carb
- GM #19244549/480 Fuel Inj., GM #19171225/515 Carb
- Any carburetor, or fuel injection engines, normally aspirated only
- Stock crate intake manifold with no modifications
- Repaired engines must use GM parts pertaining to that engine.
- any oil pan(no dry sumps or vacuum pumps allowed)any valve covers, any ignition or distributor
- **No** overbore, no sleeves, no grinding, no cutting, no filing, no milling, no porting, no balancing or engine modifications allowed, no valve seat modification, untouched factory heads only
- Modified cooling systems allowed, air/water bleed ports, can be enlarged or added, with or without water pump.
- Exhaust – any exhaust system allowed c/w mufflers
- **No Oxygenated Fuel Allowed**
- Propulsion – jet drive
- Roll bar (well mounted & braced) chrome moly recommended

**“FX” Jet Class** – 01 to 99 Series Recommended Numbers (FX99)–Crate Motor Class

- Hull any shape or material with a minimum length of 13 feet (3.96) No Glass Windshields
- Engine – GM ZZ4 355 HP **CRATE** engine GM part number 24502609 c/w stock GM intake
- Repaired engines must use GM parts pertaining to that engine.
- No sleeves, no milling, no roller rockers allowed, No porting, no polishing, no grinding, no cutting, no filing, no balancing, no port matching or modifications, no valve seat modifications, untouched factory heads only.
- any ignition system, Any oil pan(no dry sumps or vacuum pumps ), any valve covers
- Carburetor – 750 CFM maximum & 1” spacer thickness maximum 3 only 0.060 gaskets
- Exhaust – any exhaust system allowed c/w mufflers
- **No Oxygenated Fuels Allowed**
- Propulsion – jet drive
- Roll bar (well mounted & braced) chrome moly or aluminum

  - 15<sup>th</sup> place – 8 points
  - 16<sup>th</sup> place – 7 points
  - 17<sup>th</sup> place – 6 points
  - 18<sup>th</sup> place – 5 points
  - 19<sup>th</sup> place – 4 points
  - 20<sup>th</sup> place – 3 points
  - 21<sup>st</sup> place – 2 point
  - 22<sup>nd</sup> place – 1 points
2. All points from each CBF sanctioned race to the BOAT OWNER
3. \$100 per boat entry to be paid by each hosting club to Western Zone CBF for overall class prizes split 1<sup>st</sup> 50%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 30%, 3<sup>rd</sup> 20% & paid to the Boat Owner
4. The Overall Canadian Winners will be based on total time for the season for all CBF sanctioned races; this will be sponsored by Outlaw Eagle Mfg. The winning boat will be allowed to run (Canada # 1). The winning boats will have competed in all CBF sanctioned races.
5. All new racers must have an orientation course & driving test, it is suggested that they start racing in Fx Class
6. **All new racers in class must start last in the heat**
7. “All Boat Canadian Drivers” must have Pleasure Craft Operators License
8. World Anti-Doping Alcohol Code in effect suspensions issued after 0.03 alcohol level
9. **Any racers in LSX, CX or FX caught cheating with engines** will have their motor confiscated & sold with proceeds to charity, this racer will be banned for the season
10. On engine tear downs **“All Gaskets at Owners Expense”**
11. **All Costs incurred from protests will be paid by the losing party**
12. **All Engine Protest Fees \$1000.00 other Protests to remain at \$500.00**
13. **All racers must have CBF Memberships**
